**SUMMARY**

A recent quality assessment by The Boeing Company at American Metal Supply Inc. of Anaheim, CA (formally of Fullerton, CA) a distributor of aluminum, titanium, nickel, stainless steel, and alloy steel wrought products bought to AMS, ASTM, MIL, and FED specifications uncovered a number of non-conformances and substitutions that may lead to potential product and/or contractual compliance risks.
